

RESENT WITH ATTACHMENTS - Urgent Oversight Request: FCC & EPA Failure to Act on Civilian Directed Energy Exposure Complaints

Dear Committee Chair and Oversight Staff,

My name is Ms. Mechael Wright-Hoges, submitting this request on behalf of the Direct Energy Weapons Agency, Inc. (DEWA) a registered 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization headquartered in Marshfield, Massachusetts and its division, DEW Police, which documents and assists civilian victims of directed energy and "Havana Syndrome" type assaults occurring within the United States.

Since 2021, our organization has received and documented over 300 civilian incident reports describing ongoing exposure to energy-based attacks causing neurological, auditory, and physical harm. Despite multiple formal submissions to the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) and the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), and follow-up letters sent to both agencies' Inspectors General (most recently dated October 13, 2025), no federal agency has acknowledged jurisdiction or initiated an investigation.

Attached below are three official complaint communications and the FCC's written response dismissing responsibility and redirecting us to contact EPA, even though these incidents involve unregulated RF/microwave emissions and possible environmental radiation exposure, both of which fall under federal oversight.

Summary of Oversight Concerns

1. Failure to Investigate Civilian Directed Energy Reports

- No protocol or point of contact exists for U.S. civilians reporting possible directed energy assaults or "Havana Syndrome" symptoms.
- Victims who contact federal agencies are routinely referred back to local authorities unequipped to test for RF or microwave radiation.

2. Negligence in Public Safety and Environmental Protection Duties

- The FCC has statutory responsibility for regulating the electromagnetic spectrum.
- The EPA is charged with environmental health and non-ionizing radiation oversight. Both have declined to respond substantively or provide testing access to victims.

3. Request for Congressional Oversight

- That the Senate and House Committees initiate an oversight inquiry into why no interagency civilian response framework exists for directed energy or anomalous health incidents.
- That Congress recommend development of civilian testing, monitoring, and protective procedures comparable to the Havana Act (2021) framework for government personnel through the already established Direct Energy Weapons Agency, Inc.

Requested Action

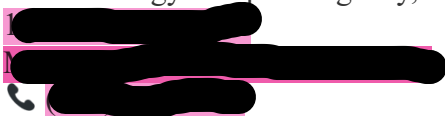
We respectfully request:

2. A recommendation for an interagency civilian protection framework for anomalous health incidents, that includes Direct Energy Weapons Agency, Inc.
3. A written confirmation that this complaint has been entered into the Congressional record.
